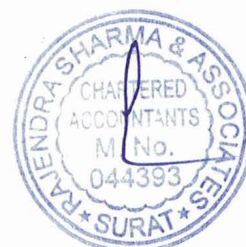

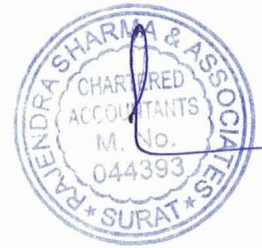

- 4 Maxum Metals Private Limited ceased to be subsidiary of Mohit Industries Limited with effect from 18th Septmebr, 2018.
- 5 With reference to auditor's qualification in limited review report dated 14th February, 2019 , the board is of the opinion that the Provision for Post Employment Benefits and other long term employee benefits are determined on the basis of actuarial Valuation Method & technique prescribed in the Ind-AS. The company has decided to pay the Post Employment Benefits and other long term employee benefits as and when they become due as the amount is negligible and is not going to make any impact on the financial Position of the company. Considering the size of the company and negligible liability, the company has not made provisions for Post employment benefits and other long term employee benefits under Defined benefits plan.
- 6 During current quarter tax expense is negative due to reduction in tax rate. As per last audited results, deferred tax provision has been made at rate of 33.06 % and the same has been reduced to 27.82%. Thus there is reduction of around 15.85% in tax rate and it resulted in reversal of tax expenses.

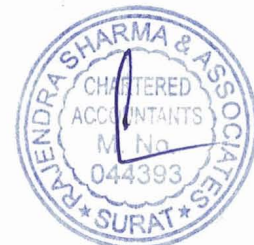

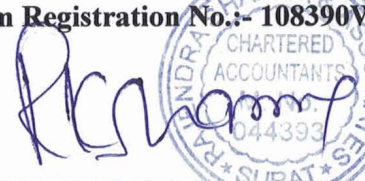

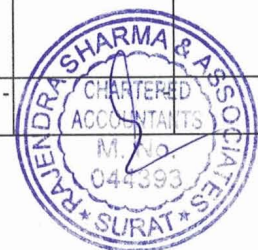
